Bill Analysis

HB 1079 creates the Ghost Gun Anti-Infringement Act. The measure provides that a personal firearm, a firearm accessory, or ammunition that is manufactured commercially or privately in Oklahoma and that remains exclusively within the borders of Oklahoma shall not be subject to federal law, federal taxation, or federal regulation. The measure also provides that the use of basic materials used in the manufacture of such items shall not subject the manufacture of firearms that remain exclusively within the borders of Oklahoma to federal regulation, taxation, or law. Any public officer or employee of this state or any political subdivision of the state who enforces or attempts to enforce an act, order, law, statute, rule, or regulation of the government of the United States in violation of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 2 years and/or a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00.
