**Bill Analysis**

HB 1633 provides that a person incarcerated in a county or municipal jail shall be primarily responsible for payment of the cost of medical care provided to the person for any intentionally self-inflicted injury sustained while in the custody of the county jail or municipal jail or a physical or mental health condition that existed prior to the arrest of the person. The person shall be charged for the medical care and treatment by the provider of the necessary care. The measure also provides that the custodial county or municipality may seek reimbursement from a person being held in custody and receiving medical care and treatment.
