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**Bill Analysis**

HB 1690 removes the requirement that the board of directors of a Federally Qualified Health Center be considered a public body and subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Meeting Act. The measure removes penalties and reporting requirements for non-compliance with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. The measure modifies the definition of “public body,” and further requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to ensure that Federally Qualified Health Centers receive at minimum, payment for services in accordance with U.S. law.
