**Bill Analysis**

HB 1776 provides that an attorney employed by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation may enter an appearance in court if requested to do so by another prosecuting authority as it relates to quashing subpoenas, other discovery matters, expungement applications, evidentiary hearings, and forfeiture proceedings. The measure also expands the requirement for a person convicted of a drug crime to provide a blood or saliva sample to law enforcement to include any person convicted under the provisions of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act.
