Bill Analysis

HB 2316 redesignates the 2-1-1 Oklahoma Coordinating Council as the Oklahoma 2-1-1 Collaborative and designates the Collaborative as the lead entity of all 2-1-1 call centers in this state. The Collaborative shall be comprised of 15 members and must meet at least 2 times per year. The Collaborative is directed to collaborate with such entities as may be required and to the extent required under federal law or to receive federal funding. Additionally, the Collaborative must provide an annual report no later than September 1 of each year to the cabinet Secretary for the cabinet area consisting of the Department of Human Services. Members shall serve without compensation or reimbursement for expenses. The measure directs the Collaborative to certify information and referral providers who wish to become 2-1-1 call centers.
