**Bill Analysis**

HB 2338 provides that the Director, department heads, emergency responders, and other essential employees of the Department of Corrections may be permitted to use a state-owned or state-leased vehicle to provide transportation between the residence of the employee and the assigned place of employment and between the residence and any location other than the assigned place of employment to which the employee travels in the performance of the official duty of the employee. Department heads, emergency responders, and other essential employees must obtain permission from the Director to receive such transportation.
