Bill Analysis

HB 2542 authorizes the admission of an attorney on a motion to practice law under certain circumstances. The measure allows an applicant, upon motion, be admitted to the practice of law in Oklahoma if the applicant graduated from an accredited law school approved by the American Bar Association, has been admitted to practice law in another state or jurisdiction of the United States, is a member in good standing in a reciprocal state, not subject to disciplinary proceedings, and has been engaged in the practice of law for a period of 5 of the preceding 7 years.
