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**Bill Analysis**

HB 2656 modifies definition of marijuana to strike the reference to cannabidiol as it relates to a federally approved drug or substance. The measure provides that any prescription drug approved by the federal Food and Drug Administration that is designated, rescheduled, or deleted as a controlled substance under federal law is to be excluded from Schedule I and must be prescribed, distributed, dispensed, or used in accordance with federal law unless the Board of Pharmacy acts. If the Board of Pharmacy does not act, the drug is deemed to be designated, rescheduled, or deleted as a controlled substance.

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
