**Bill Analysis**

HB 2665 separates the alcoholic beverage manufacturer license from the nonresident seller license and sets its fees based on the number of cases sold per year. For 50 cases or less, the licensing fee is set at \$50.00 with a \$100.00 annual fee. If the licensee sells between 51 and 500 cases, the licensing fee is set at \$75.00 with a \$225.00 annual fee. For licensees selling over 501 cases per year, there shall be a \$150.00 licensing fee and an additional \$450.00 annual fee.
