**Bill Analysis**

HB 2749 amends the Reading Sufficiency Act to require districts that receive more than \$2,500 in RSA funding to spend no less than 10% on professional development for pre-K through 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers beginning in the 2022-23 school year. It directs the professional development to include training in the science of how students learn to read. The bill directs the State Department of Education to approve and publish a list by June 30, 2022, of professional development programs that can be used.

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
