Bill Analysis

HB 2750 states legislative intent that institutions of higher education not require an Advanced Placement exam score of more than 3 for course credit. It allows a score of 3 or more to be required for granting additional course credit. The bill directs all AP exam credit policies be posted on campus websites for the 2021-22 fall term and each academic term thereafter. It directs institutions to conduct biennial reviews of their AP credit policies. It directs noncompliance to be reported to the chairs of the House and Senate education committees by Dec. 1 each year.
