**Bill Analysis**

HB 2932 provides that unless expressly authorized by the Legislature, no agency, board, commission, department, council, instrumentality, or other entity organized within the executive branch of state government shall utilize the federal funds from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) in a manner that will or likely will lead to increased demand for state-appropriated funds or any other state funds.
