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**Bill Analysis**

HB 3374 authorizes the State Board of Education to assist school district boards of education to establish pilot projects that create community schools within a school district or at a school site. Community schools are public schools that provide services and supports which fit the needs of each neighborhood. Such schools must have a designated coordinator who completed leadership training by an Oklahoman non-profit as well as a comprehensive needs assessment process. The school shall use collaborative leadership, practices, and shared responsibility as well as maintain an ongoing stakeholder engagement process. The Department is directed to promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this measure.
