Bill Analysis

HB 3421 provides that motor license agents accepting applications for driver licenses for persons 65 years of age or older or honorably discharged veterans shall retain \$6.00 for a 4- year driver license and \$12.00 for an 8-year driver license to be deducted daily by the motor license agent or licensed operator receipts. State agencies shall not retain these fees. The CS defines a licensed operator as an individual who obtains a license from the Service Oklahoma Operator Board to operate a designated Service Oklahoma location and offers third-party fulfillment of designated services to be rendered by Service Oklahoma.
