**Bill Analysis**

HB 3734 provides that any license provided by the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority shall not be issued until the applicant first obtains all relevant local licenses and permits issued by a municipality. The Authority shall not issue the license until it determines all necessary inspections and reviews such as plans reviews, life safety inspections, or compliance inspections, have been completed. The measure authorizes the Authority to issue a conditional license to an applicant if the applicant has fulfilled all other obligations required by the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act. A conditional license shall not entitle an applicant to operate or act as a licensee.
