Bill Analysis

HB 4100 authorizes the Department of Public Safety to establish Operation Work Zone Awareness. The Operation will inform and educate the public on the dangers of committing moving violations while traveling in highway construction work zones. The Department is authorized to develop and house on its website an online work zone awareness presentation that may include facts and figures representing the dangers of motorists committing work zone moving violations, testimonials from highway construction workers and their families, information on the importance of awareness and slowing down in work zones, and a question-and-answer section to ensure participants understand and retain the information presented. The Department is also authorized to contract for the production, development, and maintenance of the webpage through a vendor. Motorists issued a citation in a work zone for a moving violation may be directed to the website and, if the motorist completes the program, entitled to dismissal of the fine upon showing the certificate of completion to the court. Motorists shall only be eligible for participation in the program one time and shall pay a fee of \$75.00 to participate in the program. The fee shall be apportioned to the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund, Department of Public Safety Patrol Vehicle Revolving Fund, and the Oklahoma Court Information System Revolving Fund at \$35.00, \$15.00, and \$25.00 respectively.
