**Bill Analysis**

SB 102 requires all state agencies that provide, contract for, or otherwise fund mental health services to report to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services on or before September 30, 2021. The report will include a list of mental health services provided by the agency, a financial summary of spending amounts by method of finance associated with each program, and outcome summaries for mental health services. The Office is directed by the measure to compile agency reports and submit a unified report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House, the Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency, and the Governor. The report shall be available to the general public. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services is directed by the measure to provide technical assistance to the agencies and OMES as necessary for the compilation of this report.
