Bill Analysis

The CS for SB 1074 directs that funding from SB 1040 appropriated to the Health Care Authority be spent in the following manner:

- 1) \$24,400,658.00 to replace federal matching funds
- 2) \$53,079,162.00 for the maintenance of programs including but not limited to program growth
- 3) \$3,027,977.00 for program enhancements
- 4) Adequate funding to implement an enhanced payment for intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICFs/IID) that provide vocational services or day program services or both. The enhanced payment shall be in addition to all other reimbursement from the Authority

The measure also authorizes the Authority to pay professional expenses of the Administrator of the Authority as well as any professional expenses of employees. Additionally, the measure authorizes the Authority to transfer funds from Fund 205 to Fund 340 to satisfy claims made to the Authority under the Supplemental Hospital Offset Payment Program Act. The measure directs the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to transfer monies between the Oklahoma Health Care Authority federal and revolving funds in amounts requested by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

The Administrator of the Authority is authorized by the measure to request OMES that receipt and expenditure of unanticipated federal funds awarded after July 1, 2022, be exempt from expenditure limitations and from budgetary limitations. Additionally, the Administrator may request that the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the agency's disbursing funds to alleviate cash-flow issues.

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
