**Bill Analysis**

SB 109 directs the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (OWRB) to create standing, regional stakeholder committees for the locations listed in the measure as well as any area designated as a scenic river in order to enable conservation, recreational use, and economic development of water resources. Each regional committee shall be comprised of 9 members from entities outlined in the measure. All regional committees are empowered by the measure to petition the OWRB to initiate an instream flow study on the basin and/or river the committee represents. Each committee shall submit recommendations based on a completed instream flow study which, subject to Legislative approval, shall be promulgated in the OWRB's administrative rules.
