**Bill Analysis**

SB 1123 authorizes emergency medical technician to transport the body of a person who has died to a hospital in proximity to the scene once the attending law enforcement officer has adequately documented and preserved the conditions at the scene by photographs and measurements if said technician is the first responder on the scene. Additionally, the measure adds emergency medical technicians to the list of entities that must cooperate with the Chief Medical Examiner and all other medical examiners in making investigations.
