Bill Analysis

SB 1124 creates the Vaccine Mandate Prohibition Bill. The measure provides that a hospital, state agency, political subdivision, entity that accepts federal or state funds, private entity, or entity employing persons required to be licensed by the state shall not require a person to receive a vaccine used to prevent infection from any current or future variant of the SARS-CoV-2 virus as a condition of employment, licensure, or educational admittance. Additionally, such entities are prohibited from discriminating against persons based on vaccination status. Any entity included in this measure shall not be liable in a civil action claiming an injury from exposure or potential exposure to any current or future variant of SARS-CoV-2.
