Bill Analysis

SB 1144 strikes language limiting the number of days certain individuals can serve as substitute teachers in schools. The measure authorizes school districts to allow a substitute teacher who has a valid, lapsed, or expired certificate or who has a bachelor's degree to teach without limitation. The measure states that a substitute teacher without a valid, lapsed, or expired certificate and without a bachelor's degree is prohibited from teaching the same course or grade-level class for more than 10 consecutive school days unless the school district is granted a waiver from the State Board of Education. The measure also directs school district board of education policies regarding substitute teachers to include qualifications for substitute teachers and their pay rate.
