**Bill Analysis**

SB 1156 allows nursing facilities, assisted living centers, and residential care homes to be licensed as an adult day care center by the State Department of Health. The measure provides that the Department shall consider licensure as a nursing facility, assisted living center, or residential care home as proof of compliance with applicable standards of adult day care centers. Such entities must submit an application to the Department and pay the initial fee to be licensed as an adult day care center.
