**Bill Analysis**

SB 1169 creates the 1907 Project as a 9-member advisory committee to promote patriotic education and increase awareness of Oklahoma values. The measure directs the 1907 Project to promote awareness of certain topics as they relate to Oklahoma history, advise the governor on core principles of the founding of the state, facilitate development of the Gubernatorial 1907 Award to recognize student knowledge of Oklahoma history, advise state agencies regarding patriotic education, and facilitate, advise on, and promote other patriotic education activities. The bill directs the 1907 Project to provide a pamphlet to the Department of Public Safety by July 1, 2023, that explains the significance of policy decisions made by the state to promote liberty and freedom. It directs the Department of Public Safety to provide the pamphlet to persons issued Class D licenses. The measure additionally directs the 1907 Project to submit a report of its activities, findings, recommendations, proposals and other matters by July 1, 2023. The bill states that the 1907 Project shall end on July 1, 2037.
