Bill Analysis

SB 1184 creates the Students' Right to Know Act to help high school students make informed decisions about their futures. It directs the State Department of Education on an annual basis to compile certain employment, education, and salary information including the most in-demand jobs in Oklahoma, the average monthly student loan payment for students who attend state institutions of higher education or technology center schools, and the average starting salaries for persons graduating from state institutions from higher education or graduating from a technology center school. The measure directs the Department to post the information on its website by Oct. 15 each year so that it is accessible to every public high school in the state for school counselors to distribute to students.
