**Bill Analysis**

SB 1185 provides that, in addition to other fines and penalties, a person convicted of failure to yield to a right-of-way and caused a fatality shall be assessed a fee not to exceed \$1,000.00. Revenue from this fee shall be deposited in the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving Fund, which shall be used to promote public awareness of the dangers of driving while under the influence of alcohol or any controlled substance and to promote motorcycle safety and defensive driving for youth.
