Bill Analysis

SB 1191 creates the Oklahoma Principal Leadership Program to provide institutes with professional development to improve the quality of school principals. The measure directs the State Board of Education to identify providers to design and implement an institute and directs an institute to identify high-quality principals with which principals from school districts across the state can interact to receive professional development in leadership skills. The bill provides a process for providers to submit applications to the State Board of Education. It establishes a process for principals to submit applications to a provider. The measure states that a provider will receive funding to design and implement an institute and provide a stipend to the employing school district of a high-quality principal participating in the institute, subject to availability of funding. It directs each provider by July 1, 2024, to submit a report to the State Department of Education on implementation of the institute. The measure directs the Department to compile the reports and submit them to the chairs of the House and Senate education committees.
