## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1196 specifies that nonprofit centers must be certified and provide access to recovery supportive living environments as it relates to housing registered sex offenders. Additionally, the measure strikes language excluding trailers, recreational vehicles, and manufactured homes from the definition of "multi-unit structure" as well as language that prohibits the Department of Corrections from contracting for the housing of any person required to register as a sex offender in any individual building.
