**Bill Analysis**

SB 1205 requires the Advisory Committee on Medical Care for Public Assistance Recipients to have at least 1 pharmacist on the Committee. Additionally, the measure requires the Committee to have at least 2 members from statewide associations representing rural and urban hospitals. A rural hospital is defined by the measure as having 50 or fewer beds and an urban hospital is defined as having 100 or more beds.
