Bill Analysis

SB 1209 states that if a member or prospective member of a school district or technology center school district board of education has voted or votes in favor of knowingly violating any state law relevant to public education or within Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, he or she is not qualified to serve in the position. The measure directs the board to declare the seat of the member vacant to be filled as provided for in law and prohibits the member from serving in a paid or unpaid role for public schools in this state for 5 years.
