**Bill Analysis**

SB 1211 directs school district budget summaries to include estimates of fees or membership dues to be paid to a private organization or association that is owned, operated, or affiliated with a national entity. The measure states that such expenditures shall not be included in a school district's budget if the governing body receives substantial opposition to them. The measure defines "substantial opposition" as comments, recommendations, or information presented at a public hearing that represents 10% of the electors in a board district within the school district.
