Bill Analysis

SB 1214 directs any state agency requiring the use of masks to provide each person covered under such requirement with clear and concise instructions on proper usage and applicable warnings of any real or potential harms based on applicable guidance from health authorities. Any state agency found to be in violation of this provision shall be liable for actual damages and any employee who implements or is tasked with oversight of such a requirement who knowingly neglects to fully inform persons subject to the mask requirement shall forfeit any liability protection provided under the Governmental Tort Claims Act.
