**Bill Analysis**

SB 1229 expands the authorized use of monies from the Highway Construction Materials Technician Certification Revolving Fund to include the certification of individuals seeking to become registered as a highway construction materials technician. Monies from the Fund shall be expended by the Department of Transportation instead of the Board. The measure also strikes language providing that the Fund shall be used for examination and the execution of the powers and duties of the Board. The measure also repeals the provisions of the Oklahoma Highway Construction Materials Technician Registration Act.

**House Amendments**

HA's to the measure clarifies that monies from the Highway Construction Materials Technician Certification Revolving Fund shall be expended by the Department of Transportation.
