**Bill Analysis**

SB 1260 authorizes a commissioned officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol to keep his or her badge and firearm after resigning from the force if said officer served on the force for 20 or more years of combined service. Current law provides that an officer may only retain his or her badge and firearm after retirement.
