Bill Analysis

SB 1268 modifies the Parents' Bill of Rights. It modifies the contents of policy to be adopted by school district boards of education to include procedures for parents to register to vote and learn about upcoming elections and procedures for parents to learn about community resources such as health care, counselors, and mentors. It modifies certain policy provisions to address when parents object to learning materials or activities because the parent believes it is inappropriate for the student due to personal beliefs, religious practices, or traumatic experiences. It also provides for parents to learn about the right to access free instructional materials at school and at home and the right to opt out of district-required standardized tests, field tests, and benchmark tests at the district level that would capture data.
