Bill Analysis

SB 1273 provides that any interested member of the public may address a public body on any agenda item or item of new business in the time designated for public comment at a meeting of the public body. Members of the public are entitled to exercise all rights of free speech and assembly to address the body and no law enforcement officer or entity may prevent a member of the public from exercising such rights in a lawful manner at a meeting of the public body.
