**Bill Analysis**

SB 1274 modifies eligibility for the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP), also known as Oklahoma's Promise. Beginning with students who enroll in the program in the 2022-23 school year, the bill requires students who have graduated within the previous 3 years from a high school or the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics to have a composite score of 22 or higher on the ACT test.
