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## **Bill Analysis**

The FS for SB 1338 adds delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol, the primary psychotropic cannabinoid in marijuana, and all isomers, precursors, and other variations of tetrahydrocannabinol to the definition of Tetrahydrocannabinols as defined in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act. It classifies tetrahydrocannabinols as a Schedule I substance, other than delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol and any others specifically excepted, and exempts delta-8 tetrahydrocannabinol in a concentration of 2% or less. Delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol remains a Schedule III substance. Any tetrahydrocannabinols as defined in the measure other than delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol shall not be included in the provisions of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act and shall be subject to the newly created Schedule I provisions.

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
