**Bill Analysis**

SB 134 adds the requirement for the Judiciary Committees of the Senate and House to review the schedule of basic child support obligations every 4 years. The review must include economic data from the Title IV-D Child Support Program in the Department of Human Services and provide opportunity for public input. Information relating to the report, as well as the current membership of the Committees, must be published on both the Senate and House websites. Current law only requires the Committees to review child support guidelines.
