SB 1373 changes may to shall as it relates to employees of law enforcement or other persons reporting possible certain violations by peace officers. Such violations include domestic violence, conviction of a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, falsification or a willful misrepresentation of information in an employment application or application to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET), revocation or voluntary surrender of police or peace officer certification in another state for a violation of any law or rule or in settlement of any disciplinary action in such state, involuntary commitment of a reserve or peace officer in a mental institution, abuse of office, entry of a final order of protection against a CLEET applicant or officer, and any violation of the Oklahoma Private Security Licensing Act.
