Bill Analysis

SB 1380 prohibits authorization for school employee organization payroll deductions from exceeding one year without reauthorization. It states that if a request to terminate a deduction is submitted, no further debt from the school employee to the organization shall accrue. The bill creates the Teacher Paycheck Protection Act requiring that authorization for professional organization dues and political contributions are to be on a form prescribed by the secretary of education. It requires a school district to confirm an employee's authorization for deductions by email. It states that an authorization expires at the start of the first full pay period each school year unless it was authorized or reauthorized during the school year. The bill clarifies that its provisions apply to new collective bargaining agreements or contracts or any contract that is modified, extended, amended or changed after the bill's effective date.

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
