**Bill Analysis**

SB 1382 directs the subject matter standards for history, social studies, and U.S. government to include certain historical documents such as the Bill of Rights, the Anti-Federalist Papers, the Articles of Confederation and the Gettysburg Address. It requires high school students beginning with ninth graders in the 2022-23 school year to read the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of rights each school year until graduation. It also requires high school students beginning with ninth graders in the 2022-23 school year to read The Law by Frederic Bastiat and the 1777 version of the New England Primer at least once during high school.
