## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1389 adds child advocacy records to the list of records required to be kept confidential. Additionally, the measure provides that persons required to produce confidential records may charge for travel reimbursements in accordance with the provisions of the State Travel Reimbursement Act as well as for any parking fees incurred in the delivery of such documents. The measure also clarifies that nothing in this section of law will be construed as to authorize a person who is not a member of a multidisciplinary team to observe any services pertaining to child abuse.
