**Bill Analysis**

SB 1390 provides that the fee for the skills portion of a Class A, B, or C commercial license examination shall be fixed at \$60.00. The fee will be collected by the Department of Public Safety. Any applicant who fails to notify the Department at least 48 hours prior to missing an appointment for a skills test or provide a written medical excuse from a licensed physician, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician's assistant, shall result in forfeiture of the fee. Applicants are given 3 opportunities to pass the examination before being deemed to have failed.
