Bill Analysis

SB 1403 requires each school district board of education to adopt a part-time student enrollment policy and post it on the district's website. The measure states that districts are allowed to enroll students, including those enrolled in a private school or who are being educated by other means, on a part time basis. It directs the State Board of Education to promulgate rules to determine how part-time enrolled students are to be counted for purposes of State Aid. The bill exempts part-time enrolled students from a requirement that students in grades 9 through 12 be enrolled in a minimum of 6 periods.
