Bill Analysis

SB 1410 creates the Oklahoma Emergency Energy Availability Act of 2022. The measure provides that any agency, department, bureau, system of higher education, school district, township, or municipality that has an energy policy must develop an emergency energy plan detailing methods or sources of energy during a state of emergency. Such plans may not rely on energy from a single source and must develop policies for the acquisition of electrical power generated from at least 3 distinct energy sources.
