**Bill Analysis**

SB 1420 creates the Fund Students, Not Systems Scholarship Act and the Fund Students, Not Systems Scholarship Program to provide scholarships to attend a private school of choice to students who are eligible to enroll in pre-kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade in a public school district in this state. Beginning in the 2022-23 school year, the scholarship can be awarded to a student if his or her parent or legal guardian requests one. The bill provides for calculation of the scholarship amount and establishes eligibility criteria for private schools to participate.
