**Bill Analysis**

SB 1430 increases the maximum speed allowed to motorized scooters to 35 mph as well as increases the piston or rotor displacement from 35 to 50 cu cm. The measure also provides that a person must be at least 14 years of age to operate a motorized scooter. Unless required by local ordinance, operators of motorized scooters shall not be required to have a driver license or comply with the vehicle insurance or financial responsibility laws.

**House Amendments**

HA's to the measure increases the maximum speed from the engrossed version from 30 to 35 mph and adds language exempting operators from driver license and insurance requirements.
