**Bill Analysis**

SB 1435 expands the membership of the advisory committee appointed by the Director of Human Services to include representatives of associations relating to child care and expands the responsibilities of the committee to include providing advice, recommendations, and guidance regarding concerns brought by child care facilities. The committee shall also assist child care facilities in reaching minimum requirements. The measure also strikes language specifying the exact membership of the committee and instead requires that a majority of any committee appointed to recommend requirements and standards shall be representatives of the type of licensed child care programs that are the subject of the requirements and standards. Additionally, advisory committees relating to family care homes, child care centers, residential programs, and the Quality Rating and Improvement System are created by the measure.
