Bill Analysis

SB 1439 directs the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigations to post a publicly accessible list on its web site of any person convicted of a felony offense related to injuring an animal. The list shall include a photograph of the offender, but not the person's social security number, driver license number, or any other state or federal identification number of the person. The measure directs the court clerk to forward court convictions of such offenders to the Bureau within 21 days of the conviction. After the 1st conviction, the OSBI shall maintain the name and other identifying information for 2 years following the date of the conviction. For 2nd and subsequent convictions, the OSBI shall maintain such information on its site for 5 years after the date of conviction.
